

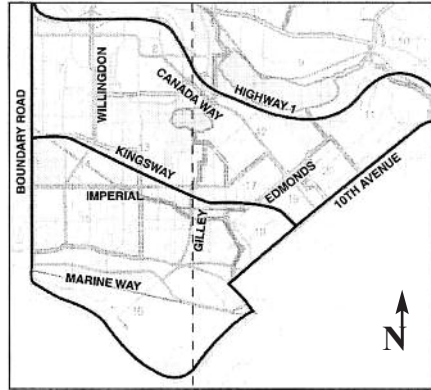
PROGRAM GOALS

The Neighbourhood Small Grants Program is intended to support projects that will improve the neighbourhood socially, physically or culturally. It is a community building initiative that will help individuals develop leadership skills and community pride, build awareness of community organizations, and catch residents' attention in a new and exciting way.

A minimum of 20 small grants from \$50 to \$500 will be awarded to projects approved by two committees of local residents. Approved projects will include some that make physical improvements, some events, and projects that reflect the diversity of South Burnaby neighbourhoods.

PROGRAM RULES

1. Projects should improve the neighbourhood socially, physically or culturally.
2. The project (including field trips) must occur within the South Burnaby neighbourhood boundaries (**see map at right**).
3. The two project applicants must live within the neighbourhood boundaries (**see map at right**) and should not reside at the same address.
4. The project must be completed between **April 16 and October 31, 2010 (inclusive)**.
5. The project must comply with Burnaby city bylaws and appropriate permissions must be obtained.
6. The project must be socially acceptable to the majority of the neighbourhood.
7. Registered organizations/societies are not eligible for funding.
8. Private, family-only or professional events are not eligible.
9. The applicant cannot profit financially from the project.
10. **Events must be FREE OF CHARGE to all participants.**
11. The maximum grant award is \$500.00. Applicants may request the full grant or less than that amount. Committee members may award requested amount or less at their discretion.
12. Project organizers who receive funding will document their event with photos and display those photos at a project-end celebration.
13. Project organizations will submit an expense report at the end of the project.
14. The deadline for grant applications is **4:00 pm on Wednesday, March 31, 2010**.
15. Approved projects should represent the diversity in the neighbourhood.
